Final Stop: Lincoln Memorial



Scheme of Maneuver (Example):

- Olympus has QIC for Start Point at Lincoln Memorial
 - Olympus QIC leads Warm –Up, Initial Beatdown, and Veterans Day history lesson of Lincoln Memorial
- Upon completion, QIC for Korean Memorial (The General) leads PAX to Memorial
 - Repeat as above
- Upon Completion, QIC for Jefferson (The Farm) leads PAX to Memorial
 - Repeat as above
- Repeat as above
 - Repeat as above
- Finish at Lincoln Memorial
